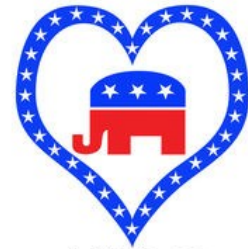
Let's show our support to the Tree of Life organization for the great work they are doing in our community by honoring them with donations at our next meeting on January 28th. See you all there!

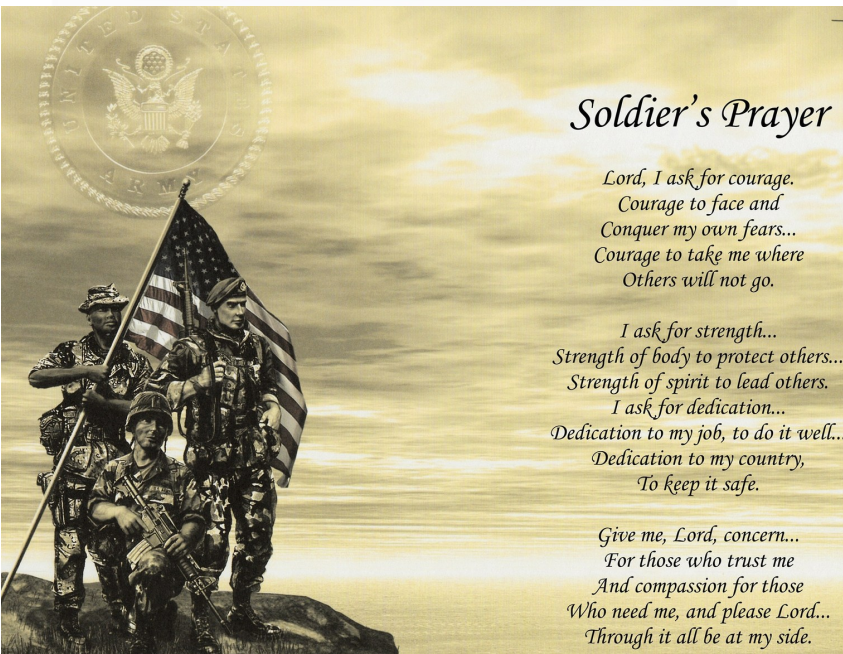
