Speakers for October were: Monty Clouse

Monty Clouse spoke about an article he wrote called “How Democrats Are Grooming Assassins To Take out Trump.” It was published in the Federalist, an American conservative online magazine that covers culture, politics, policy and religion.

Monty said it was an uncomfortable hypothesis to write about. How did it come to be that one guy tried to kill President Trump in July, and another one was ready to kill him in September? The thinking was that if Trump was assassinated in real time and we all saw it, we would be impressed with the state’s power, the left’s reach. We’d be very intimidated. By the grace of God we didn’t have to go through that, but how did we get here?

The left has not just tried to marginalize Trump. They have tried to demonize and dehumanize him. They have tried to get Trump to be so reviled and rejected by everyone that nobody wants to see him or listen to him. Verbal threats started in 2017. Madonna infamously said “I have thought quite a lot about blowing up the White House.” The next thing we saw was Kathy Griffin holding an image of Trump’s bloody head. We are all free speech advocates, so we accept that they can say these things and not go to jail. But there was not enough outrage. We can’t ignore these things. We have to deal with and take action against them.

For years now there have been organized, collaborative, sustained operations by the deep state and legacy media against Trump. The deep state has marinated the American population with daily, repeated, inflammatory media lies and assertions, which has given them an extraordinary amount of power over people’s thinking and information. We have to consider the uncomfortable possibility that we are part of a national level, psychological operation.

Most Americans cope with this in various ways, but some misfits are compelled to act violently. The people who have acted violently against Trump and other Republican political leaders in past years, to quote from Monty’s article, “. . . represent different cohorts of the pipeline of assassins cultivated by our federal government, the Democrat party, and the legacy media. Monty led members of ARWF in a letter-writing project that targeted Christian voters in swing states who haven’t voted in recent, past elections. Hopefully, we helped encourage reluctant Christian voters in those states to vote. And, Monty reminded us that if any of our contacts need us to pick up and turn in their ballots, we should offer to do it!

2024 Caring For America

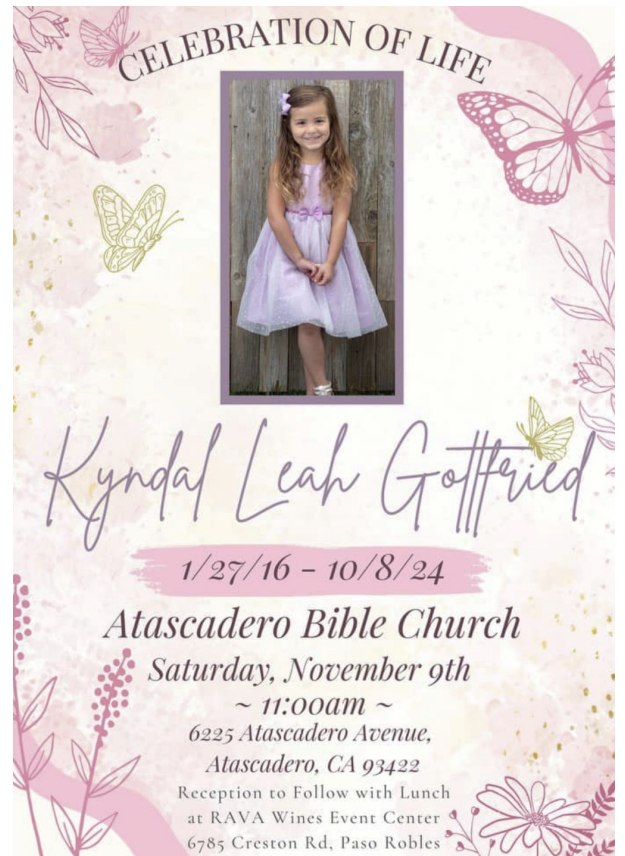

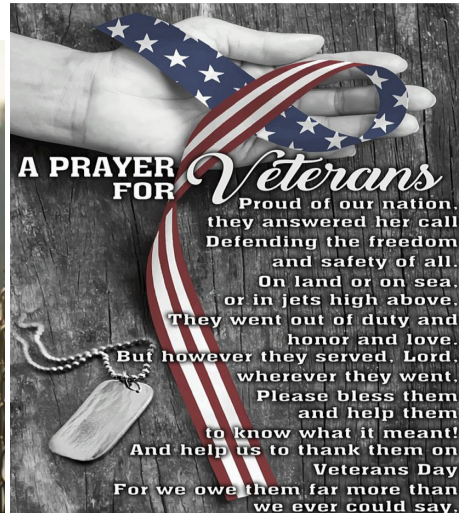

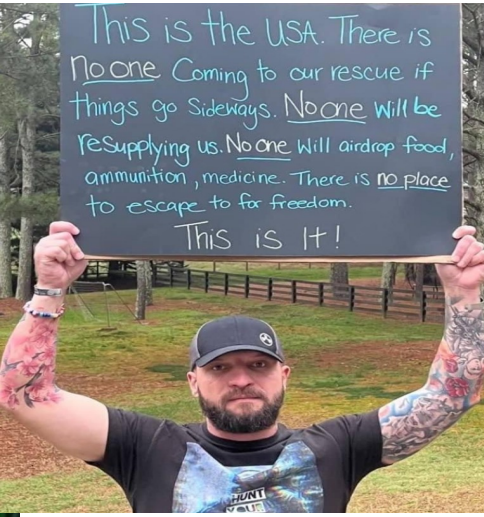
